Pre-Junior/Junior (maximum24)

These sessions are for skaters who are working on Preliminary tests and or skaters moving up from pre-junior to junior. Skaters who have passed the Preliminary Freeskate test may skate this session.

Registration fee: 2 days \$115.00

Registration forms will be accepted by mail or in person starting April 1st 2008. Enclose payment of 50% of the fees to reserve your spot. Full time skaters will have priority.

A \$35.00 Skate Canada Fee will be charged to all non Skate Canada members.

Availability of ice time on any given day is limited to the number of skaters that can safely practice on the ice. Skaters who are registered full-time will be given first priority. Availability will then be based on the number of days skating and a first come, first served.
